Non-emergency contact Safeguarding (9am-5pm; Monday - Friday);

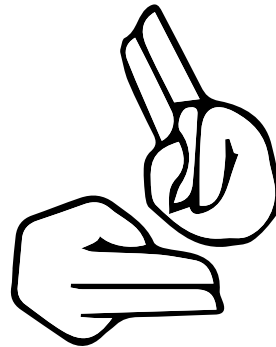
